Your application will only be considered if it contains all of the following:

- Completed answers to all applicable questions in the space provided.
- A cover letter describing up to three activities from the last year in which you demonstrated leadership-in-action. Explain in detail what you did, what was accomplished and how your action made a difference. The letter must not exceed two pages.
- Current transcript from your college or university.
- Two letters of recommendation. The letters must be written by individuals who can attest to the activities described in the cover letter.

Please do not staple or bind your application. Use a paper clip to secure your application.
